Reconnecting the Nature:

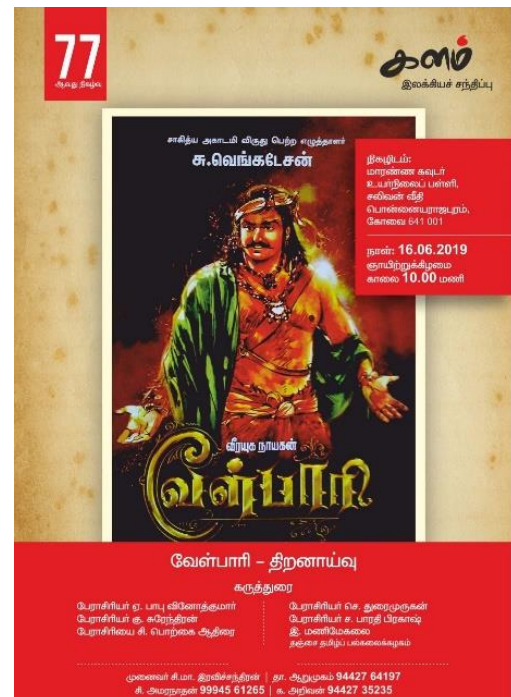
